
- Data that is freely used, reused and distributed by anyone
















Likelihood of search by stop-cause



This chart displays the relative statistical likelihood of one racial/ethnic group being searched as compared to another group for a given stop cause. Adjusting the drop down menu will display the relative likelihood of search relative to another racial group on a year-by-year basis. Click the colored circles above the graph to display the comparisons between various racial and ethnic groups.


